Her home collections of bed linen, cushions, kilims and rugs for Atelier Pfister further demonstrate her talent for multidisciplinary design.

As one of the winners of the recent Design Prize Switzerland-Edition 2013/14, Caviezel was invited to participate in the Westbund Art and Design Fair Shanghai, which



took place in a vast renovated hangar at the former Longhua Airport in September 2014. For the fair she created the beautiful textile wallcovering *Naturaleza*, printed on Trevira CS by Mitlödi Textildruck AG in collaboration with Création Baumann, Switzerland. The 8 x 5 metre textile depicts an exotic paradise, a landscape of layered flowers, animals and foliage against a green background of giant sweeping brushstrokes.
